

Love One Another Verses

Purpose of the markings is to encourage better understanding and application.
Ledge of the following markings.

Green is for the verbs that the reader **does**.
The phrase or sentence that the reader **does** is underlined.
Red is for what the reader does not do.
Yellow is for **who God is and what He does.**
Blue is for prayers by the reader.

Here are the Bible verses that contain the three words love one another; and the phrase is made extra large to stand out in the context for example this **love one another**.

Notice how the yellow and green highlighted part are closely related.

Jesus spoke red lettered words in the following gospel of John passages.

Joh 13:34 **A new commandment I give to you, that you **love one another**, just like I have loved you; that you also **love one another**.**

Joh 13:35 **By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you have **love** for one another."**

Joh 15:12 **"This is my commandment, that you **love one another**, even as I have loved you.**

Joh 15:13 **Greater love has no one than this, that someone **lay down** his life for his friends.**

Joh 15:14 **You are my friends, if you **do** whatever I command you.**

Joh 15:15 **No longer do I call you servants, for the servant doesn't know what his lord does. But I have called you friends, for everything that I heard from my Father, I have made known to you.**

Joh 15:16 **You didn't choose me, but I chose you, and appointed you, that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain; that whatever you will ask of the Father in my name, he may give it to you.**

Joh 15:17 **"I command these things to you, that you may **love one another**.**

Rom 13:8 **Owe no one anything**, except to **love one another**; for he who **loves** his neighbor has fulfilled the law.

1Th 4:9 But concerning brotherly love, you have no need that one write to you. **For you yourselves are taught by God to love one another.**

1Pe 1:22 Seeing you have purified your souls in your obedience to the truth through the Spirit in sincere brotherly affection, **love one another** from the heart **fervently**:

1Jo 3:11 For this is the message which you **heard** from the beginning, that we should **love one another**;

1Jo 3:12 unlike Cain, who was of the evil one, and killed his brother. Why did he kill him? Because his works were evil, and his brother's righteous.

1Jo 3:13 **Don't be surprised**, my brothers, if the world hates you.

1Jo 3:14 We know that we have passed out of death into life, because we **love** the brothers. He who doesn't **love** his brother remains in death.

1Jo 3:15 Whoever hates his brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life remaining in him.

1Jo 3:16 **By this we know** love, **because he laid down his life for us**. And we ought to **lay down** our lives for the brothers.

1Jo 3:17 But whoever has the world's goods, and sees his brother in need, and closes his heart of compassion against him, how does the love of God remain in him?

1Jo 3:18 My little children, **let's not love in word only, neither with the tongue only**, but **in deed and truth**.

1Jo 3:19 And by this we **know** that we are of the truth, and **persuade** our hearts before him.

1Jo 3:20 because if our heart condemns us, **God is greater than our heart, and knows all things**.

1Jo 3:21 Beloved, if our hearts don't condemn us, we **have boldness toward God**;

1Jo 3:22 and **whatever we ask**, we **receive** from him, because we **keep his commandments and do** the things that are pleasing in his sight.

1Jo 3:23 **This is his commandment**, that we should **believe** in the name of his Son, Jesus Christ, and **love one another**, **even as he commanded**.

1Jo 3:24 He who **keeps** his commandments remains in him, and he in him. By this we **know** that he remains in us, **by the Spirit which he gave us**.

1Jo 4:7 Beloved, let us **love one another**, **for love is of God**; and **everyone who loves** is born of God, and **knows** God.

1Jo 4:8 He who doesn't love doesn't know God, for God is love.

1Jo 4:9 By this God's love was revealed in us, that God has sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him.

1Jo 4:10 In this is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son as the atoning sacrifice for our sins.

1Jo 4:11 Beloved, if God loved us in this way, we also ought to **love one another.**

1Jo 4:12 No one has seen God at any time. If we **love one another**, God remains in us, and his love has been perfected in us.

2Jo 1:5 Now I beg you, dear lady, not as though I wrote to you a new commandment, but that which we had from the beginning, that we **love one another.**
